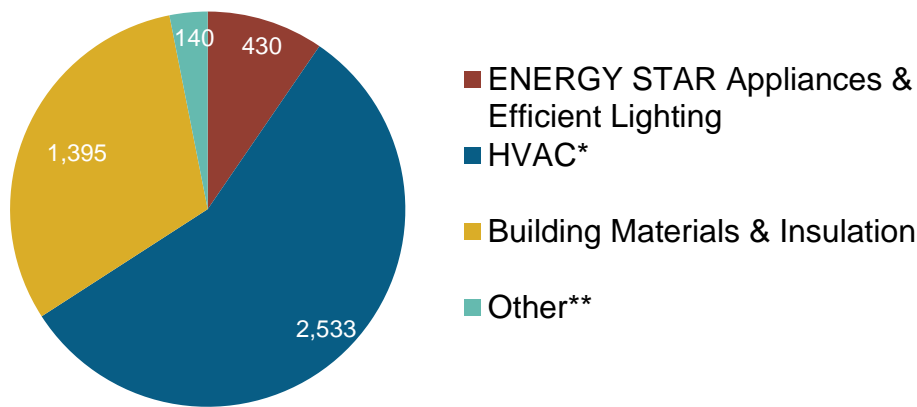

 \*\*Other such as energy audits, building certifications, and software services

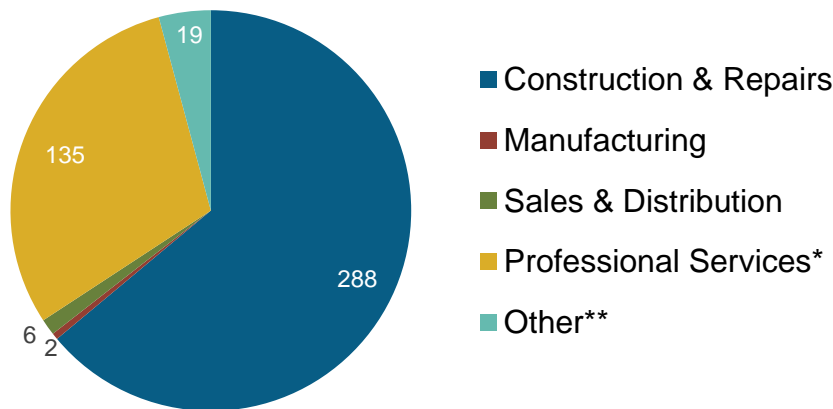

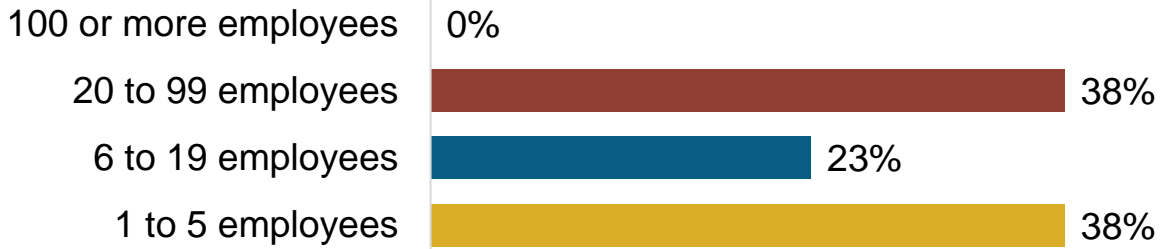

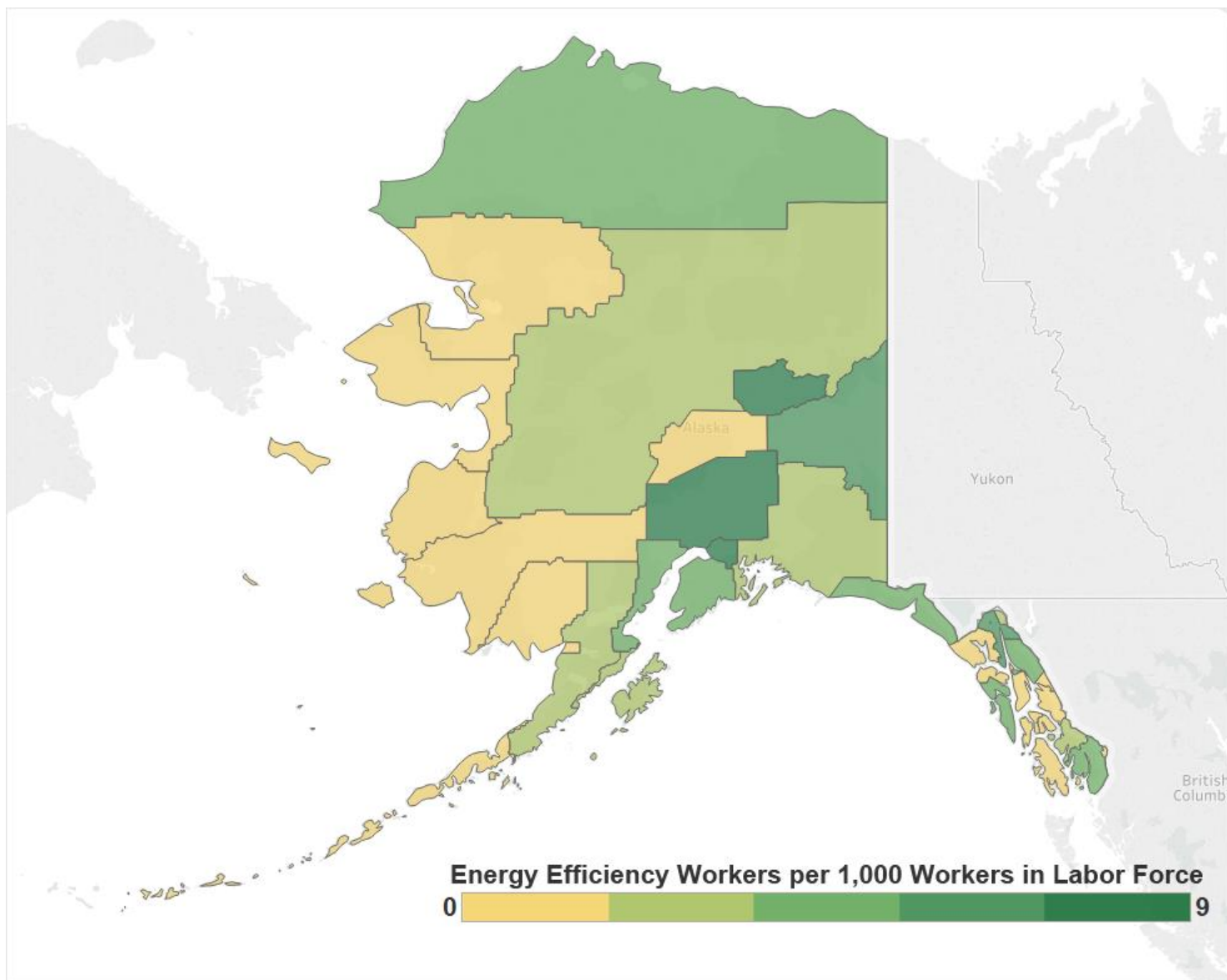
